2. Presentation of the VAL's different schedules: (See DOC posted outside – rue Victor Hugo)

Lunchtime - 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.:

The canteen shift schedule is still in place, with priority given to Year 2 pupils (CP) early this year.

This system encourages the smooth integration of CP pupils. Children from other levels can show up when they are hungry: This organisation facilitates the effective monitoring of the shift schedule supported by the VAL Team. VAL. Canteen assistants also sign up in a notebook to help with the calling of names and the distribution of trays.



Children's dietary requirements are noted and discreetly displayed in the canteen.

If a parent has any concerns, they should not hesitate to contact the VAL team.

Activity rooms, table football, football and the library are available for children.

No ball games outside of supervised football sessions and no ball games on Thursdays.

New rule: personal balls are no longer allowed at school.

For this first period, the VAL team has implemented a listening and setting rules session. It involves gathering all the children in the class and raising their awareness on listening and following rules. It is quite interesting as the children reveal the problems they see, experience or have caused.

Wednesdays:

VAL Wednesdays begin at 11:30 a.m. with a gathering of all the children. Then the VAL team communicates important information and explains the activities and outings planned for the day. Registration for VAL outings (ice rink, cinema, park, etc.) takes place at this moment. The VAL team keeps an up-to-date outing tracking table to ensure the same children do not always go on outings. The day ends at 5 p.m. after snack time. Parents can pick up their children between 5 p.m. and 6:43 p.m. at the gate, then until 6:45 p.m. at the 17 Rue Ficatier door.

Otherwise, no early departure will be permitted. Only children registered with the MDPH (local authority for disabled persons) or children with a medical condition incompatible with the day's activities are permitted to leave early.

At the beginning of the year, activities with no specific themes were offered to the children. A suggestion box will be made available to allow them to share their ideas with the VAL team. Afterwards, a theme will be proposed every term.

Fridays (NAP - New After-School Activities):

Fridays start at 11:30 a.m. for children who eat in the canteen or at 1:30 p.m. for children who eat at home. Children may also leave after lunch at 1:30 p.m.

As for activities, external activity monitors will be present during each period, either on site or outside the school. See the period table posted on the outside notice boards.

The activity team members offer ongoing activities that kids enjoy and that are complementary to the activities offered by the external activity monitors.

Activity registration:

Children register at the beginning of each term. They can choose a preferred activity and a second activity in case there is not enough space in their first choice. In this way, the VAL team ensures that children's choices are respected and frustration is avoided.

After-school garderie:

For 45 minutes, children can play in the playground or go to the VAL room on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Children must be careful to collect their belongings before leaving the school, as school rules prohibit them from re-entering the school once they have left, or going back into classrooms once they have left them.

The VAL Director is present for closure on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

The VAL Deputy Director is present for closure on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

3. Information for parents:

As an ALSH (**A**ccueil de **L**oisirs **S**ans **H**ébergement- day Activity centre), the VAL team must have in its possession vaccination records, school insurance and signed up-to-date information sheets.

The VAL team understands that these procedures may be complicated, but they are mandatory.

The information sheet can be found in your online 'Espace Famille'; it is marked 'VAL' on the top left-hand corner. Please check that you are up to date, particularly if you are still required to submit vaccination records or school insurance for 2025/2026.

After the Toussaint holidays, for safety reasons, children without a form will not be allowed to leave the school grounds.

In addition, children who return home alone must provide an authorisation to do so (issued by the VAL team) in addition to the information sheets. It states the times when the child is allowed to return home alone.

Our outdoor notice board contains (or should contain):

- Wednesday schedule
- Nap schedule (= Fridays New After-School Activities)
- Items prohibited or permitted at school (sweets, food, personal items, balloons, make-up).

FYI : Skipping ropes (especially maxi ropes) and hoops are not permitted without supervision for Year 2 pupils (CP).
