1. Wednesday Projects / NAP

Themes for Wednesdays

Period 4 (March to April): “Investigations and Explorations.” This period made it possible to:

- Assess curiosity and encourage critical thinking.
- Organize large-scale games.
- Set up an escape game for 15 children.
- Study and observe children’s behaviour (INCA).
- Adjust the organization following changes to lunchtime games.

Period 5 (May to June): Back to the Future. This period focuses on:

- Discovering activities and professions of the past, present, and future.
- Highlighting children as active participants in their day through activities prepared for others and supervised by the facilitators.

News

- Reintroduction of ball games in the playground.
- Activities are supervised by a facilitator and child assistant referees, promoting responsibility, listening skills, and fair play.
- Creation of new assistant roles for children, in addition to the existing “mediators.”
- Strong voluntary participation: time is needed to explain the roles to ensure attentive and caring behavior.
- Return of “rab” at the canteen (distribution of leftover food), but too many children are requesting it from the facilitators: discussions are underway.
- A dedicated and marked area has been set up for skipping ropes, elastic games, and hoops.



3. Child Climate

The VAL team notes an improvement compared to the beginning of the year.

A sanctions scale has been implemented and displayed.

Reflection sheets and the trust contract remain in place.

School holidays have been beneficial for the children.

The succession of public holidays in May is currently causing a noticeable increase in excitement and enthusiasm among students.

4. Questions and Comments from Parent Representatives

- **A canteen visit is scheduled for June 3, 2026, with parent representatives and elected officials.**

This visit will not reflect the usual canteen operations, as there are fewer children on Wednesdays and an Accrocamp outing is taking place the same day.

Parent representatives will request that next year's visit be scheduled on a Monday, Tuesday, or Thursday.

- **Why are the M. Achard and Jean de la Fontaine schools closing this summer?**

Both establishments will undergo construction work this summer.

- **All children attending the elementary schools on Rue Victor Hugo must go to the Colombes leisure center this summer, as it is the only facility open in the area. Impact: significant distance.**

The Malraux school could have been used as a leisure center, but unfortunately, the neighborhood has been neglected.

- **How are budget allocations determined?**

They are made per center and per year, based on school holidays. Each city operates differently.

- **It would be useful to create a photo directory (trombinoscope) of the facilitators in addition to the team members.**
